He continued: "This high-level engagement with the Qatari delegation marks another milestone in the Foundation's journey to build relationships that advance development and unlock shared opportunities. As Qatar continues to expand its presence and partnerships across the African continent, events such as these help create pathways for investment, cooperation, and long-term socio-economic growth."

The invite only event will be held in Waterfall City, one of South Africa's most celebrated examples of modern urban development. The location was selected to give guests an

### **About Rali Mampeule**

Over the past five years, Rali Mampeule has cemented his reputation as a visionary entrepreneur and philanthropist.

He is the Founder of the South African Housing and Infrastructure Fund (SAHIF), which has delivered over 68,000 housing stands across South Africa, and an investor in MetroFibre Network, which provides fibre connectivity to more than 510,000 homes nationwide.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, he supported the Ikemeleng Community in Roodepoort, donating 75 temporary housing units to shelter more than 300 people.

In 2023, the Mampeule Foundation, in partnership with the Department of Science and Innovation (DSI) and the University of Johannesburg (UJ), unveiled South Africa's first 3D-printed house, a landmark step toward sustainable, affordable housing solutions.

Mampeule is also a supporter of youth development through initiatives such as Green Riders, which aims to create 50,000 green jobs over the next five years, and the Supreme Fight League (SFL), which empowers young South Africans in sport.

Together with his wife, Makentse Mampeule, he has sponsored over 90 students through the Foundation's bursary programme and continues to champion global health through the Global Surgery Foundation in Switzerland.
